The British Textile Employers Association

The British Textile Employers Association (BTEA) was formed on 1st April 1969 by the amalgamation of the British Spinners and Doublers Association, The United Kingdom Textile Manufacturers Association and The Textile Finishers Association. It was a national organisation covering, in theory, the UK and Northern Ireland but the majority of members were active within a 30 mile radius of Manchester. The membership comprised persons, firms and bodies corporate carrying on business in spinning, doubling, weaving, knitting, finishing and other stages of the processing of cotton, man-made and allied fibres. It did not include firms engaged in the growing or production of raw materials but there was a provision for Associate membership of organisations but not individual undertakings in allied fields. Of the latter, there were 3 namely The Bleachers, Dyers and Finishers Association Incorporated (Belfast); The Dyers and Finishers Association (Bradford Yorks.) and The Macclesfield Textile Manufacturers Association (Macclesfield).

While the forerunners of the BTEA were formed out of ten or more bodies originally composing them and formed to fight the cornering of the cotton market in one case or the strength of Trade Unionism in the case of another. The BTEA was formed so that the industry, which up to 1969, had liased loosely, to formulate policy on commercial and industrial questions and to speak and act with one voice. The archive is from the Association's offices that were on the fifth floor of the Royal Exchange Building in Deansgate, Manchester. From the material listed it seems that there is very little documentation prior to the last war. During December 1940 the Royal Exchange was gutted by enemy action at the height of the blitz. At that time the building was occupied by the Master Cotton Spinners Association Ltd any pre war documentation originated elsewhere. For example, the library may have been housed at the Cotton Board who were situated at the Midland Bank in Spring Gardens, other earlier material may have come from the Fine Spinners and Doublers Ltd. 6 St James's Square Manchester.
